MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Emerging Business Owner (\$50 per year)

For a new business owner (in business for three years or less). A non-voting category limited to two years, members receive all communications and publications, are eligible for all discounts and benefits, and are listed in the annual directory.

Supporting Member (\$100 per year)

For individuals who subscribe to the mission of NAWBO and wish to lend support to NAWBO through membership. (This is the ideal category for local corporate partners.) A non-voting category, members receive all communications and publications, are eligible for all discounts and benefits, and are listed in the annual directory.
