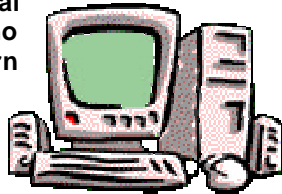

Special Interest Groups

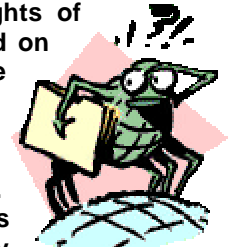
